

# YOUR DENTAL VISIT GUIDE

## DURING THE CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK

### BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT

We will phone you a few days before your appointment. We will ask you some screening questions about Covid-19, and check we have up-to-date information regarding your medical history and any medications.



### ON THE DAY



Please arrive on time and attend alone where possible. Bring minimal belongings with you. Try to wear a face covering or mask. Remember, toilet facilities and the waiting room will not be routinely available. Our staff will be screened daily for signs of Covid-19.

### WHEN YOU ARRIVE

Our door will be locked - ring the doorbell. We will let you in, take your temperature, and repeat the Covid-19 screening questions. You'll be asked to use hand sanitiser and wear a mask if you don't already have one. You'll then be escorted to the dental surgery



### IN THE DENTAL SURGERY



The dentist and nurse will be wearing PPE - dont forget its still us underneath! We will go ahead with your treatment - there may be some things we have to do differently to normal. For your safety, the surgery and communal areas will be disinfected after every patient

To limit personal interaction, payments and further appointments will ideally be arranged over the phone and we politely ask you not to linger in the practice after completion of your treatment
